Heritage Language Classes - Guidelines

Holy Ghost School offers Polish and Tagalog Heritage Language Classes to students during the Before School Program.

Heritage Language Classes are held on all days that the school is open for regular classes.

Program Attendance

Program Start Date: 1st school day in October

Program End Date: last school day in June

Class Time: 7:45am - 8:30am

Fees

One Child	\$350.00
Two Children	\$460.00
Three Children	\$550.00

Billing

Families are required to register and pay the fees in full on or before October 1st of the current school year.

- **Late Fee** – A late fee of \$100.00 will be applicable to any payments not received by October 1st.
- **NSF Cheques** - A \$25.00 returned cheque fee will be applicable for any cheques that are returned NSF.

Early Arrival

Students who attend Heritage Language Classes will be required to attend the Before School Program if they arrive at the school more than 10 minutes before these classes start at 7:45am.

If a Heritage Language Class is cancelled unexpectedly, the student will be required to attend the Before School Program but will not be billed from 7:45am to 8:30am.

General Rules

- The children are not allowed to leave the classroom without permission from the Heritage Teacher.
- All regular school rules will apply to the children.

Inclement Weather

If Holy Ghost School is closed due to inclement weather, Heritage Language Classes will also be cancelled.

Cancellation of Program

In any given school year, Polish or Tagalog classes may be cancelled if less than 12 students register for the class.
